<u>Utility Bill:</u> Provide a full and recent copy of the SCE bill for all **benefitting meters**, and **indicate which meter will be the generating meter** (the meter that is physically connected to the system)

- 1. Please provide a list of all benefitting/aggregate meters and indicate the order in which you want the excess power to be allocated across those meters.
- 2. Total past usage history for each meter (sum of the past 12 months worth of usage in kWhs).

<u>Parcel #</u> for each parcel on which a meter is located. If there are multiple parcels, indicate which meter is on which parcel.

<u>Sales/Installation Contract</u>: Please provide a copy of the executed contract between the installer and customer.

<u>Please NOTE</u>: SCE charges a \$75 application fee. SepiSolar will pay this fee on the customer's behalf, but will invoice the fee amount when the application is submitted.

**NEMA ELIGIBILITY:

The main two requirements that SCE checks for to determine eligibility for the NEM Aggregation (NEMA) program are:

- all meters must be on either the same parcel or parcels which are adjacent/contiguous, and
- all accounts for all meters must be in the same name AND that name must also match the parcel/property owner name. If
 the parcel/property owner name does not match the name on the SCE accounts, they will request to either have the parcel/
 property owner name added to the SCE account OR they will request us to submit a lease agreement between the two
 entities
